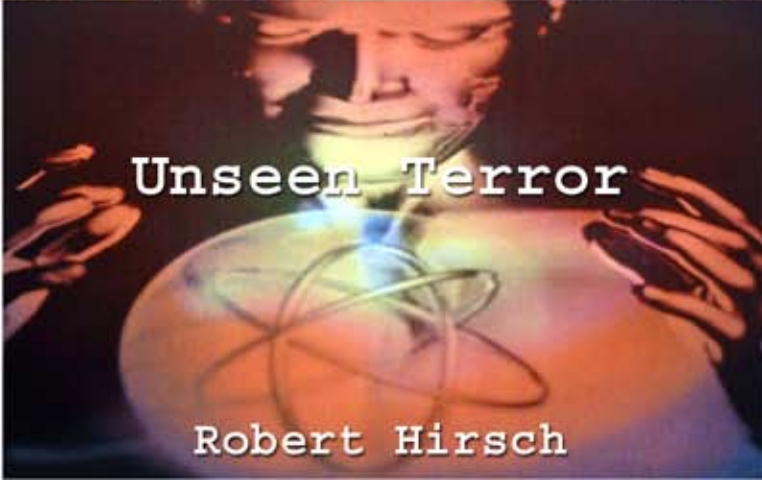
Number of U.S. nuclear bombs lost in accidents and never recovered: 11

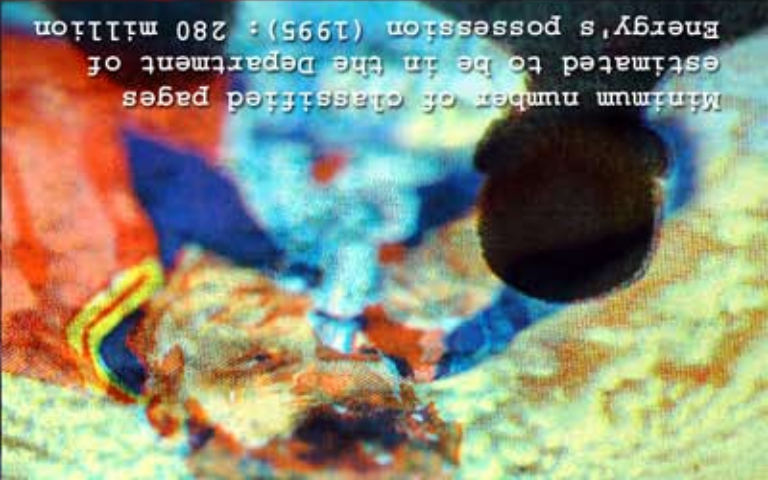


Total number of nuclear missiles built, 1951 to present: 67,500
